BCI completes Worcester move

WORCESTER — Behavioral Concepts Inc., which specializes in the care of children with autism in Central Massachusetts, recently completed the relocation of its Worcester care center to 345A Greenwood St., Suite B.

A day school, to be called the Center for Applied Behavioral Instruction, is tentatively scheduled to open at the location in early 2014, pending approval from the Worcester School Committee.

The agency's preschool, the Accelerated Learning Academy, will open in the fall of 2014. Students at the Accelerated Learning Academy will be taught using behavioral teaching methodology.

Through its host of services and programs, BCI helps children with autism and autism spectrum disorders develop learning skills and social skills. In addition, BCI works with families of children with autism and related disorders to alert them to services provided by the school system and by their health insurance.

A grand opening celebration for the new center is planned for later this year or early 2014. BCI's corporate offices are in Mansfield.
